LI082P High Risk Work Exclusion - applicable to the Liability Section

If in relation to any claim **You** have failed to fulfil any of the following conditions **You** will lose **Your** right to indemnity or payment for that claim

- 1 **You** must ensure that in connection with **Damage** to underground pipes cables or other services
- 2 **You** must maintain in force a system of work for controlling the risks associated with digging excavating boring or similar work and before starting such work **You** must
 - (i) take (or cause to be taken) all reasonable steps including contacting the appropriate authorities to find out whether any pipes cables or other services which could be at risk are under the site
 - (ii) keep a written record of the steps taken
 - (iii) inform whoever is carrying out the digging excavating or boring of the location of any pipes cables or other services
- 2 **We** will not provide indemnity in respect of
 - (i) piling work water diversion or the use of explosives
 - (ii) the construction of or work on towers steeples chimney shafts blast furnaces viaducts bridges docks tunnels dams or reservoirs
 - (iii) digging below 8 metres
 - (iv) the felling or lopping of trees
 - (v) partial or total demolition of buildings or structures unless this forms part of a contract undertaken by **You** for the erection alteration maintenance or repair of buildings or structures
 - (vi) the use of heat producing equipment away from premises which **You** own hire or rent
- 3 Other than as set out in 4 below **We** will not be liable for the first 10% or GBP1000 whichever is the greater of **Compensation Costs and Expenses** subject to a maximum contribution by **You** of GBP2500 in respect of any one claim
- 4 **We** will not be liable for the first GBP2500 in respect of **Damage** to optical fibre cables
